Historically the Authority has provided an opportunity for members of the public to meet with the Elected Members of the Board at publicly attended surgeries hosted at The Hub on Second Avenue in Onchan.

At the Ordinary Meeting of the Board held on 6th February 2023 the Board agreed that the publicly attended surgeries will be held every two months and that the frequency of the surgeries be brought back before the Board for further review. The above named commercial property that is in the ownership of the Authority has recently become vacant at short notice. The property was leased to Adorn Leasing Limited (formally Manx Carephone and Monitoring Services Limited and Adorn Domiciliary Care Limited) from 2006 until 2024.

As part of the due diligence before re-letting the property it has been discovered that planning permission was not obtained prior to the previous tenant occupying the premises to allow it to be used as an office. The property currently has planning permission to be used as a doctor's surgery as approved in 1982 as per planning application reference X1887.

A Certificate of Lawful Use application will be submitted to the Planning and Building Control Directorate for their consideration to retrospectively obtain planning permission for the property to be used as an office.

The property is due to be publicly advertised for re-letting via Deanwood and the Authority's social media page and website.
