- I have read the public statement from Mr Scott Wilson alleging a current serving MHK may have breached the Tynwald code of conduct in relation to being involved in his work as a civil servant;
- Please supply all correspondence, emails, letters etc that surround Mr Wilson and the MHK involved.

Response issued:

If you are not satisfied with the result of the review, you then have the right to appeal to the Information Commissioner for a decision on:

- Whether we have responded to your request for information in accordance with Part 2 of the Freedom of Information Act 2015; or
- Whether we are justified in refusing to give you the information requested.

In response to an application for review, the Information Commissioner may, at any time, attempt to resolve a matter by negotiation, conciliation, mediation or another form of alternative dispute resolution and will have regard to any outcome of this in making any subsequent decision.
